Chaney (HB 589)

Relative to the high school curriculum that certain students must successfully complete to be eligible for an award pursuant to the Taylor Opportunity Program for Students:

Existing law (in addition to other curriculum requirements) provides that through the 2012-2013 school year, a student must take one unit of World History, Western Civilization, or World Geography and that beginning with the 2013-2014 school year and thereafter a student must take two units from among such courses.

Relative to requirements beginning with the 2013-2014 school year and thereafter, <u>new law</u> provides instead that a student must take two units from among World History, Western Civilization, World Geography, or History of Religion.

<u>Existing law</u> (in addition to other curriculum requirements) requires students to take a oneunit Fine Arts Survey class. However, authorizes students to substitute courses in performing or visual arts for the Fine Arts Survey course. <u>Prior law</u> required two units of performing or visual arts as a substitute. <u>New law</u> requires only one unit from among such courses.

<u>Prior law</u> further authorized a student to substitute any other course in the TOPS curriculum for the Fine Ares Survey. <u>New law</u> removes this option.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 24, 2011).
