

New law adds certain advertisements by a physician holding himself out to the public in any manner as being certified by a public or private board as cause for the La. State Board of Medical Examiners to refuse to issue or suspend or revoke any license or permit, or impose probationary or other restrictions on the license of the physician, unless certain criteria are satisfied.

New law requires a physician to list his qualifications for performing the advertised medical procedures in his advertisement, if he advertises and does not meet any of the criteria articulated in new law.

Effective August 15, 2011.
