# ACT No. 863

HOUSE BILL NO. 203

BY REPRESENTATIVE LEGER

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 27:247, relative to the casino support services contract; to  
3 provide for compensation to the parish for providing support services; to provide for  
4 an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 27:247 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §247. Casino support services contract

8 Subject to and in accordance with the provisions of this Chapter, the gaming  
9 control board shall enter into a casino support services contract with the governing  
10 authority of the parish where the official gaming establishment is located in order to  
11 compensate the parish ~~on a quarterly basis~~ for the cost to the parish for providing  
12 support services resulting from the operation of the official gaming establishment  
13 and the activities therein. Support services as used in this Section shall include but  
14 not be limited to fire, police, sanitation, health, transportation, and traffic services.  
15 The amount of the contract shall be determined by negotiation and agreement  
16 between the gaming control board and the parish, subject to approval by the Joint  
17 Legislative Committee on the Budget. In the event that a new contract is not agreed  
18 upon by the gaming control board and the parish by March thirty-first of any year,  
19 the contract currently in effect shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Committee  
20 on the Budget for approval of the amount of the contract at the next meeting of the  
21 committee. If the committee approves the amount of the contract, the contract shall  
22 remain in full force and effect. If the committee disapproves or does not act upon  
23 the amount of the contract, the contract shall be null, void, and of no effect.

1           Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
3 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
4 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
5 effective on the day following such approval.
