Gisclair HB No. 140

Abstract: Provides for changes to the board of directors of the Lafourche Parish Tourist Commission.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the governing authority of any parish may form and create a tourist commission.

<u>Present law</u> specifically creates certain tourist commissions including the Lafourche Parish Tourist Commission composed of all the territory in Lafourche Parish.

<u>Present law</u> provides that, unless provided otherwise, a commission shall be governed by a board of seven directors to be appointed by the governing authority of the parish.

<u>Present law</u> provides that, unless provided otherwise, appointments shall be made from a list of nominees submitted to the governing authority by private, nonprofit groups that have an interest in one or more aspects of the tourism industry.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for an exception with respect to the Lafourche Parish Tourist Commission. Provides that the commission shall be governed by a board of nine directors; otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.
