James HB No. 213

Abstract: Extends the category of persons which a named insured may exclude on his automobile liability policy.

<u>Present law</u> requires every operator of a motor vehicle in the state of Louisiana to provide proof of financial responsibility by acquiring automobile liability insurance in accordance with the provisions of <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> provides that a named insured may exclude from coverage persons who dwell in the same residence as the named insured by agreeing with the insurer to designate such person as a named excluded person.

<u>Proposed law</u> extends <u>present law</u> to allow named insureds to further exclude any such party, regardless of residence, who has reasonable access to operate the covered automobile.
