2 to change the limit; and

3 WHEREAS, R.S. 39:52.1 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 provides that
4 a change to the expenditure limit shall be made pursuant to a concurrent resolution adopted
5 by a favorable vote of two-thirds of the elected members of each house directing the
6 commissioner of administration to change the expenditure limit to a designated amount for
7 a specified fiscal year.

8 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of
9 the elected members of each house concurring, does hereby direct the commissioner of
10 administration to change the expenditure limit for Fiscal Year 2013-2014 from Fifteen
11 Billion Six Hundred Eighty-Six Million Six Hundred Forty-Six Thousand Four Hundred
12 Twenty-Four and No/100 (\$15,686,646,424.00) Dollars to Twelve Billion Nine Hundred
13 Sixteen Million One Hundred Forty Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Four and No/100
14 (\$12,916,140,954.00) Dollars.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this Resolution shall be
16 construed to affect the expenditure limit for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 and thereafter in
17 accordance with Article VII, Section 10(C) of the Constitution of Louisiana.
