FLOODING/CONTROL: Provides with respect to the Southeast La. Flood Protection Authorities

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 38:330.1(C)(2)(c) and (3)(a), relative to the Southeast Louisiana
3	Authorities; to provide for the nominating committee; to provide for the authority of
4	the chairman of the nominating committee; to provide for the notice of committee
5	vacancy; and to provide for related matters.
6	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
7	as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
8	Louisiana.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 38:330.1(C)(2)(c) and (3)(a) are hereby amended and reenacted to
11	read as follows:
12	§330.1. Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authority-East and Southeast
13	Louisiana Flood Protection Authority-West Bank; territorial jurisdiction;
14	board of commissioners; appointments; terms; compensation; vacancy;
15	officers; meetings; domicile

1	(c) The secretary of state chairman of the committee shall be the custodian
2	of the records of the nominating committee. The chairman of the committee, or in
3	his absence, the secretary of state, shall call the meeting of the nominating
4	committee. The secretary of state or his designee shall serve as secretary for the
5	nominating committee.
6	(3)(a) Within ten days after the effective date of this Section, the governor
7	shall advise the secretary of state of the vacancies on a board. Within ten days after
8	the occurrence of a vacancy on a board, the authority shall advise the secretary of
9	state of the vacancy. Within fourteen days after being advised the occurrence of a
10	vacancy on a board, the secretary of state chairman of the committee shall publish
11	notice of the vacancy in the official journal of the state and of each parish within the
12	territorial jurisdiction of the authority.

14	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
15	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
16	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
17	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
18	effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Provides with respect to the nominating committee of the board of commissioners of the Southeast La. Flood Protection Authorities.

<u>Present law</u> names the secretary of state as custodian of the records of the nominating committee. In the absence of the nominating committee chairman, the secretary of state shall call the meeting of the nominating committee of which the secretary of state or his designee shall serve as secretary.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> to remove the secretary of state from the nominating committee in any capacity. The chairman of the committee shall be custodian of the records of the nominating committee and shall call the meeting of the nominating committee.

<u>Present law</u> requires the governor to advise the secretary of state of the vacancies on a board within 10 days after the effective date of <u>present law</u>. Within 10 days after the occurrence of a vacancy on a board, the authority shall advise the secretary of state of the vacancy. Within 14 days after being advised of the occurrence of a vacancy on a board, the secretary of state shall publish notice of the vacancy in the official journal of the state and of each parish within the territorial jurisdiction of the authority.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> no longer requires the governor to advise the secretary of state of the vacancies on a board. The authority is no longer required to advise the secretary of state of the vacancy.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the chairman of the committee to publish notice of the vacancy in the official journal of the state and of each parish within the territorial jurisdiction of the authority within 14 days of the occurrence of a vacancy.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
