A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 1 2 To suspend until sixty days after final adjournment of the 2014 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana the provisions of R.S. 17:63 relative to single-member 3 districts for members of the Iberville Parish School Board for election of board 4 5 members in 2014 and thereafter. WHEREAS, R.S. 17:63, as enacted by Act No. 650 of the 2010 Regular Session of 7 the Louisiana Legislature, provides for single-member districts for the Iberville Parish 8 School Board to be applied to the redistricting of the school board following the 2010 federal 9 decennial census for the regular election of board members in 2014 and thereafter; and 10 WHEREAS, the provisions of R.S. 17:63, as enacted by Act No. 650 of the 2010 11 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature, have not received preclearance pursuant to the Voting Rights Act (42 U.S.C. S.1973). 12 13 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby suspends the provisions of R.S. 17:63 providing single-member districts for members of the Iberville 14 Parish School Board to be elected at the election for board members in 2014 and thereafter. 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this suspension shall become effective upon adoption of this Resolution and shall extend through the sixtieth day after final adjournment 17 of the 2014 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana. 18
