The original instrument and the following digest, which constitutes no part of the legislative instrument, were prepared by Sharon F. Lyles.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> provides that the contract limit for any contract by a public entity to restore or rehabilitate a levee which is not maintained with federal funds or to perform mitigation on public lands owned by the state or a political subdivision shall be equal to the sum of \$1,000,000, provided that the project is undertaken by the public entity with its own resources and employees or with the resources and employees of another public entity through a cooperative endeavor or other agreement with such entity.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> to provide an annual limit not to exceed \$1,000,000 applies to any work undertaken by a public entity with its own resources and employees, or with the resources and employees of another public entity through a cooperative endeavor agreement, to restore or rehabilitate a levee not maintained with federal funds, including mitigation on public lands owned by the state or a political subdivision; further provides that annual limit includes labor, materials, and equipment, which is not publicly bid, as per the rates in the latest edition of the Associated Equipment Dealers Rental Rate Book and administrative overhead not to exceed 15%.

Present law terminates on December 31, 2014.

Proposed law extends termination date to December 31, 2018.

Effective January 1, 2014.
