HB No. 502

Abstract: Allows the year-round taking on private property of outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, and beaver at night with or without dogs.

Present law, on private property, authorizes the taking of outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, and beaver at night from the beginning of March through Aug. by the landowner or his lessee or agent, with written permission and the landowner's contact information. Requires notification to the parish sheriff at least 24 hours ahead of time of the intent to do so.

Proposed law removes the requirement that a lessee or the landowner's agent have possession of written permission from the landowner, with his contact information.

Proposed law allows such hunting all year and with or without the aid of dogs. Retains notification requirement to the parish sheriff.
