COURTS. Provides for a statewide increase in court costs in city, parish, district, appellate, and supreme courts. (2/3-CA7s2.1) (8/1/13)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 13:126.1, 352.1, 841.4, 1213.3, 1912, 2157.1, 2500.4, 2520, and 2565, relative
3	to additional court costs or fees; to provide for additional fees or costs on writs and
4	appeals filed with the Supreme Court and all courts of appeal; to provide for
5	additional court costs or fees in all district courts, the New Orleans Civil District
6	Court, all city and municipal courts, the city courts of New Orleans, the municipal
7	court of New Orleans, the traffic court of New Orleans, and all parish courts; to
8	provide for the collection, disposition, and use of fees; and to provide for related
9	matters.
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. R.S. 13:126.1, 352.1, 841.4, 1213.3, 1912, 2157.1, 2500.4, 2520, and
12	2565 are hereby enacted to read as follows:
13	<u>§126.1. Additional fees; Judicial College</u>
14	A. In addition to all other fees or costs provided for by law, the clerk of
15	the supreme court shall be entitled to collect one dollar for the initial filing in
16	all civil cases. This fee shall not include any writs or appeals filed in juvenile
17	and family cases.

2	deposited into a special account and transmitted monthly to the Louisiana

7	A. In addition to all other fees or costs provided for by law, the clerks
8	of all of the courts of appeal shall charge and collect one dollar for the initial
9	filing in a record of appeal or an application for writs in all civil matters. This
10	fee shall not apply to any writs or appeals filed in juvenile and family cases.
11	B. All fees collected pursuant to Subsection A of this Section shall be
12	deposited into a special account and transmitted monthly to the Louisiana
13	Judicial College to defray the costs associated with the Judicial College's
14	general growth and program improvement strategies.

16	§841.4. Additional court costs in civil and traffic matters; Judicial College
17	A. In addition to any other fees or costs imposed or authorized to be
18	imposed and collected, the clerk of court of each district court shall demand and
19	receive from each party liable for court costs the additional sum of one dollar
20	for the initial filing in all civil and traffic matters. This fee shall not apply to
21	juvenile and family cases.
22	B. All fees collected pursuant to Subsection A of this Section shall be
23	deposited into a special account and transmitted monthly to the Louisiana
24	Judicial College to defray the costs associated with the Judicial College's
25	general growth and program improvement strategies.

27	§1213.3. Additional court costs in civil and traffic matters; Judicial College
28	A. In addition to any other fees or costs imposed or authorized to be

10	§2520. Additional court costs in traffic matters; Judicial College
11	A. In all prosecutions in the Traffic Court of New Orleans, including all
12	traffic violations other than parking, there shall be taxed as costs against every
13	defendant, who is convicted after trial or plea of guilty or nolo contendere or
14	who forfeits his bond, the sum of one dollar, which shall be in addition to all
15	other fines, costs, or forfeitures lawfully imposed.
16	B. All fees collected pursuant to Subsection A of this Section shall be
17	deposited into a special account and transmitted monthly to the Louisiana
18	Judicial College to defray the costs associated with the Judicial College's
19	general growth and program improvement strategies.

21	§2565. Additional court costs in civil and traffic matters; Judicial College
22	A. In addition to any other fees or costs imposed or authorized to be
23	imposed and collected, the clerk of each parish court shall demand and receive
24	from each party liable for court costs the additional sum of one dollar for the
25	initial filing in all civil and traffic matters.
26	B. All fees collected pursuant to Subsection A of this Section shall be
27	deposited into a special account and transmitted monthly to the Louisiana
28	Judicial College to defray the costs associated with the Judicial College's
29	general growth and program improvement strategies.

DIGEST

<u>Proposed law</u> requires an additional court cost or fee of \$1 to be collected for the initial filing in all writs or appeals filed in the La. Supreme Court and all courts of appeals relative to civil matters and further provides that the additional cost shall not apply to juvenile or family cases.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires for an additional court cost or fee of \$1 to be collected for the initial filing in all civil and traffic matters by the clerks of the following courts: all district courts, city and municipal courts, the city courts of New Orleans, the municipal court of New Orleans, the traffic court of New Orleans and all parish courts.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires each court to create a special account to deposit all collected fees and to transmit fees monthly to the La. Judicial College to defray the costs associated with the Judicial College's general growth and program improvement strategies.
