HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 16

HOUSE/RULES: Requires a display of the running tally of votes to be visible to the members while voting

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To adopt House Rule 10.10 of the Rules of Order of the House of Representatives to require
3 the running tally of votes to be visible to each member in the chamber while voting.

4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana
5 that House Rule 10.10 of the Rules of Order of the House of Representatives is hereby
6 adopted to read as follows:

7 Rule 10.10. Voting Display

8 There shall be a display in the House Chamber which allows the actual
9 running tally of yea votes and nay votes to be visible to each member of the House
10 of Representatives in the House Chamber while members are voting.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature
12 of Louisiana that the provisions of this Resolution shall become effective on the twenty-first
13 day after its adoption.
