1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To recognize April 30, 2013, as Junior League of Louisiana Day.

3 WHEREAS, the Junior Leagues of Louisiana have long been recognized as
4 organizations of women across Louisiana committed to promoting volunteerism, developing
5 the potential of women, and improving communities through the effective action and
6 leadership of trained volunteers; and

7 WHEREAS, the Junior Leagues of Louisiana play a crucial role in promoting and
8 improving women's and children's quality of life by addressing particular issues, primarily
9 safety, education, childcare, health and nutrition, adoption, and foster care, throughout
10 Louisiana; and

11 WHEREAS, the Junior Leagues of Louisiana have identified these women's and
12 children's issues because they have a significant impact on the current and future quality of
13 life for the citizens of Louisiana; and

14 WHEREAS, Louisianians should be made aware of the importance of improving the
15 lives of women and children in the state of Louisiana and the tremendous benefits associated
16 with doing such; and

17 WHEREAS, Louisianians should be made aware of the thousands of dedicated Junior
18 League volunteers and community partners who spend countless hours and human and
19 capital resources aimed at improving the hundreds of communities throughout the state of
20 Louisiana; and

1 WHEREAS, the Junior Leagues of Louisiana, whose membership is comprised of
2 homemakers, professionals, and community leaders, have tremendous influence on making
3 the state of Louisiana a better place for all of us to live; and

4 WHEREAS, the Junior Leagues of Louisiana, through their State Public Affairs
5 Committee and community partners, are holding activities and special events to further
6 educate and inform federal, state, and local government and community leaders, and the
7 general public, on the importance of women's and children's issues including safety,
8 education, childcare, health and nutrition, adoption, and foster care.

9 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
10 recognize April 30, 2013, as Junior League of Louisiana Day.
