Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Original House Bill No. 177 by Representative Leger

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, after "as" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof "an"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 8, after "learning;" and before "to authorize" insert the following:

5 "to authorize the Institute for Public Health and Justice to work in partnership with the
6 Department of Public Safety and Corrections, youth services, office of juvenile justice; to
7 provide for use of the data shared by the office of juvenile justice;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 18, after "designated" and before "advisor" delete "to be the primary
10 researcher for and" and insert in lieu thereof "as an"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 2, delete lines 6 through 8 in their entirety

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 2, at the beginning of line 9, change "(2)" to "C.(1)"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6

16 On page 2, at the beginning of line 12, change "(3)" to "(2)"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 7

18 On page 2, at the end of line 13, delete "monitor" and insert in lieu thereof "review"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 8

20 On page 2, between lines 18 and 19, insert the following:

21 "E. The Institute for Public Health and Justice may work in
22 partnership with the Department of Public Safety and Corrections,
23 youth services, office of juvenile justice, to fulfill the purposes of this
24 Chapter. Any release of data by the office of juvenile justice shall be
25 subject to approval by the deputy secretary for youth services.
26 Information may be provided on a per project basis, and the Institute
27 for Public Health and Justice shall maintain the confidentiality of
28 legally protected juvenile information. The Institute for Public
29 Health and Justice shall not use any information shared pursuant to
30 this Subsection for any proprietary purpose."
