1 A RESOLUTION

2 To recognize Tuesday, April 16, 2013, as Clergy Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.

3 WHEREAS, People Improving Communities through Organizing (PICO) is a
4 nonprofit, interfaith, multiethnic, cross-cultural, and interracial group of ordinary people
5 learning to become leaders in our community by putting their faith into action; and

6 WHEREAS, PICO provides training in community organizing in order to empower
7 leaders to become activists for positive change; and

8 WHEREAS, on Tuesday, April 16, 2013, PICO Louisiana and One Voice, along with
9 the Louisiana Legislative Black Caucus, are hosting Clergy Day at the Capitol; and

10 WHEREAS, on this day, clergy from across Louisiana will convene in the Louisiana
11 State Capitol in unity; and

12 WHEREAS, Clergy Day at the Capitol offers the faith community an opportunity to
13 mobilize in a proactive way to speak against any income tax or sales tax plans that would
14 hurt poor and working families but also in support of lifelines to healing, health care,
15 transportation, and housing issues.

16 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
17 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize Tuesday, April 16, 2013, as Clergy Day at
18 the Louisiana State Capitol.
