4	WHEREAS, Jonathan Lambert, a native of Madisonville, Louisiana, and a junior at
5	Louisiana State University (LSU), has been awarded five thousand dollars as a 2013 Udall
6	Scholar; and
7	WHEREAS, Jonathan Lambert is now the third Udall Scholar chosen from LSU; and
8	WHEREAS, the Morris K. Udall and Stewart L. Udall Foundation is an independent
9	federal agency that was established by congress in 1992 to provide federally funded
10	scholarships for college students intending to pursue careers related to the environment, as
11	well as to American Indian students pursuing tribal public policy or health care careers; and
12	WHEREAS, Mr. Lambert is a member of the LSU Honors College and is double
13	majoring in coastal environmental science and marine biology; he is currently participating
14	in research on storm surges that is being conducted by the Coastal Flooding Research Group
15	of the Department of Geography and Anthropology; and
16	WHEREAS, Jonathan Lambert received the National Oceanic and Atmospheric
17	Administration Ernest F. Hollings Scholarship in 2012; and
18	WHEREAS, following graduation in May 2014, Mr. Lambert wishes to obtain a Ph.D.

- 4 colleges and universities; and
- 5 WHEREAS, this prestigious honor is awarded based on the candidate's commitment
- to a career in the environment, Native American health care, or tribal public policy; the 6
- 7 candidate's leadership potential, academic achievement, and record of public service are also
- 8 vital factors in determining scholars; and
- 9 WHEREAS, it is a great honor for Jonathan Lambert to have been chosen for a Udall
- 10 Scholarship, an honor for which the House of Representatives of the Louisiana Legislature,
- 11 Louisiana State University, and the state of Louisiana are understandably proud of
- 12 Mr. Lambert.
