COMMITTEE STUDIES. Requests the Senate Committee on Local and Municipal Affairs to study the laws applicable to local public entities in the purchase of vehicles for law enforcement purposes.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To urge and request the Senate Committee on Local and Municipal Affairs to study the laws
3	applicable to local public entities in the purchase of vehicles for law enforcement
4	purposes.
5	WHEREAS, local public entities that utilize police vehicle patrols generally have a
6	proportionally lower crime rate than communities that do not use such a process; and
7	WHEREAS, it is very important that law enforcement officers have vehicles with
8	peak performance, cutting edge safety features, impressive cargo capacity and efficient
9	ownership cost; and
10	WHEREAS, competitive bidding is a widely used procurement method; and
11	WHEREAS, with competitive bidding the customer can wait a long period of time
12	for products or services that may be required quickly; and
13	WHEREAS, R.S. 38:2212.1(A)(2)(a) allows a local governmental unit to purchase
14	a used or new motor vehicle for conversion into a law enforcement vehicle without the
15	purchase being let for bid as long as the purchase does not exceed twenty thousand dollars;
16	and
17	WHEREAS, laws such as R.S. 38:2212.1(A)(2)(a) should be studied to determine
18	whether the state should revise such statute so the threshold amount be more reflective of

data found in the United States Bureau of Labor Statistic's Consumer Price Index for similarly-situated purchases.
