HB No. 605

Abstract: Excludes certain property from the boundaries of the Gentilly Development District.

Present law creates the Gentilly Development District in the parish of Orleans as a political subdivision of the state. Provides that district boundaries shall encompass the area included within the following perimeter: Bayou St. John, Robert E. Lee Boulevard, Leon C. Simon Boulevard, the Industrial Canal, I-10, and I-610. Provides that the governing authority of the city of New Orleans shall have such power and control over and responsibility for the functions, affairs, and administration of the district as provided in present law. Provides that the district is governed by a six-member board of commissioners.

Proposed law retains present law but excludes certain property from the boundaries of the district.
