Miller HB No. 404

Abstract: Requires the St. Charles Parish Clerk of Court to perform the functions of the jury commission in that parish.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a jury commission in each parish to perform functions including coordination of the jury venire process.

In East Baton Rouge Parish, <u>present law</u> requires the function of the jury commission to be performed by the judicial administrator of the 19th Judicial District Court or a deputy judicial administrator. In Lafourche Parish, <u>present law</u> authorizes the function of the jury commission to be performed by the clerk of court or a deputy clerk of court.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> except it requires the clerk of court of St. Charles Parish to perform the functions of the jury commission in that parish.
