Abstract: Requires the St. Charles Parish Clerk of Court to perform the functions of the jury commission in that parish.

Present law provides for a jury commission in each parish to perform functions including coordination of the jury venire process.

In East Baton Rouge Parish, present law requires the function of the jury commission to be performed by the judicial administrator of the 19th Judicial District Court or a deputy judicial administrator. In Lafourche Parish, present law authorizes the function of the jury commission to be performed by the clerk of court or a deputy clerk of court.

Proposed law retains present law except it requires the clerk of court of St. Charles Parish to perform the functions of the jury commission in that parish.
