## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation is anticipated to result in an expenditure increase of approximately \$1 M. The expenditure increase is due to various programming modifications needed for the elections mainframe computer system (\$300,000) and reprogramming all voter machines (\$300,000).

In addition, the Secretary of State anticipates other increased expenditures associated with training personnel in the clerks of courts and registrar of voters offices (\$200,000) and implementing a statewide media campaign (\$200,000). The training costs would include travel to various clerks of court and registrar of voters to train workers in new procedures implemented because of the change to a party primary for congressional elections.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
