The commissioner of insurance shall require a criminal history record check on each applicant in accordance with this Subsection. The commissioner of insurance shall require each applicant to submit a full set of fingerprints in order for the commissioner of insurance to obtain and receive National Criminal History Records from the Criminal Justice Information Services Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

(3) The commissioner of insurance may contract for the collection, transmission, and re-submission of fingerprints required under this Subsection. If the commissioner of insurance does so, the fee for collecting and transmitting fingerprints and the fee for the criminal history record check shall be payable directly to the contractor by the applicant. The commissioner of insurance may agree to a reasonable fingerprinting fee to be charged by the contractor.

40(4) The commissioner of insurance shall treat and maintain an applicant's41fingerprints and any criminal history record information obtained under this Section42as confidential and shall apply security measures consistent with the Criminal Justice43Information Services Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation standards for44the electronic storage of fingerprints and necessary identifying information and limit

1	the use of records solely to the purposes authorized in this Section. The fingerprints
2	and any criminal history record information shall be exempt from the public records
3	law, R.S. 44:1 et seq., shall not be subject to subpoena, other than a subpoena issued
4	in a criminal proceeding or investigation, shall be confidential by law and privileged,
5	and shall not be subject to discovery or admissible in evidence in any private civil
6	action."
