
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary B to Original Senate Bill No. 159
by Senator Morrell

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "require payments for a" and insert "provide relative to"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 3, after "employment" delete the remainder of the line and insert "; to
5 provide relative to communications; to provide relative to administrative fees; to provide
6 relative to public records; to provide relative to medicare and social security contributions;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 4, delete "instances;"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, delete lines 9 through 14 and insert the following:

11 **"A. All offices, officers, and staff managing police details and secondary**
12 **employment shall be prohibited from communicating with the New Orleans**
13 **Police Department, its staff, officers, or superintendent. Communicating with**
14 **the Public Integrity Bureau is excepted from this prohibition.**

15 **B.(1) The head of the Office of Police and Secondary Employment shall not be**
16 **within the chain of command of the New Orleans Police Department but shall**
17 **be bound to observe the Police Officers Bill of Rights and shall be prohibited**
18 **from disciplining an officer, and shall not restrict access to details without due**
19 **process through civil service. Civil service shall promulgate rules to resolve**
20 **OPSE complaints.**

21 **(2) The chief management officer for the OPSE shall refer all complaints of**
22 **unprofessional conduct to the Public Integrity Bureau.**

23 **C. The OPSE will be responsible for workers' compensation and all related**
24 **insurance costs of officers on detail or secondary employment.**

25 **D. The maximum administrative fee on hourly detail or secondary employment**
26 **shall be five dollars per hour.**

28 **E. The city of New Orleans shall be responsible for any tax associated with**
29 **payment of the five dollar administrative fee by any entity.**

30 **F. Each assignment of paid police detail and secondary employment, as well as**
31 **any exempted detail or details exempted from rotation, the name of any**
32 **coordinator assigned to such detail, as well as the rationale given for any**
33 **exemption from detail policy or procedure shall be a public record subject to**
34 **the Public Records Law.**

36 **G. The city of New Orleans shall be responsible for the funding and payment of**
37 **social security and Medicare employer and employee contributions for all detail**
38 **or secondary employment and shall not deduct any such contributions from**
39 **hourly rates established for officers on details.**

1 **H. Any communication regarding the chief management officer of the OPSE**
2 **shall be a public record and subject to the Public Records Law and also be**
3 **available under the Freedom of Information Act.**

4 **I. As used in this Section, "OPSE" shall mean the Office of Police and**
5 **Secondary Employment. "**
