SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Recognizes May 15, 2013, as Warrick Dunn Charities Day at the state capitol

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To recognize Wednesday, May 15, 2013, as Warrick Dunn Charities Day at the state capitol  
3 and to welcome Warrick Dunn to the capitol.

4 WHEREAS, Warrick Dunn, a Baton Rouge native, graduated from Florida State  
5 University and was a first-round draft pick in the National Football League in 1997; and

6 WHEREAS, Warrick Dunn founded a charity organization, Warrick Dunn Charities,  
7 which focuses on providing programs and services for single parents; and

8 WHEREAS, the signature program of Warrick Dunn Charities is Homes for the  
9 Holidays, now in its sixteenth year, which provides single parents who are first-time home  
10 buyers with down payment assistance and home furnishings; and

11 WHEREAS, Homes for the Holidays has helped one hundred twenty-three single  
12 parents and three hundred thirty-four children achieve a long-term stable home environment;  
13 and

14 WHEREAS, Betty's Hope, known as the bereavement program on wheels, is the most  
15 recent program of Warrick Dunn Charities; and

16 WHEREAS, Betty's Hope is a mobile counseling center that provides grief support  
17 to schools and community centers on a scheduled basis; and

18 WHEREAS, on Wednesday, May 15, 2013, the Louisiana House of Representatives  
19 will welcome Warrick Dunn to the state capitol and will pause to commend him for all of  
20 his charitable work which contributes so significantly to the betterment of the state of  
21 Louisiana; and

1           WHEREAS, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana wishes to  
2 recognize Warrick Dunn for his manifold contributions and service to the youth and less  
3 fortunate of his community and the state of Louisiana.

4           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
5 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize Wednesday, May 15, 2013, as Warrick Dunn  
6 Charities Day at the state capitol and does hereby welcome Warrick Dunn to the state  
7 capitol.

8           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted  
9 to Warrick Dunn.
