Provides relative to the lease of a hospital by a Jefferson Parish hospital service district

Purpose of the Bill: This measure will allow hospital service districts in Jefferson Parish to lease a hospital(s) owned by the hospital service district with approval of the governing authority rather than the currently required vote by the district electors.
