HB No. 470

Abstract: Prohibits dogs from being transported in the back of pickup trucks or utility trailers on interstate highways unless properly crated or secured.

Proposed law prohibits drivers from transporting dogs of all breeds in the back of pickup trucks or utility trailers on interstate highways within this state.

Proposed law provides for exceptions relative to dogs enclosed in a crate, container, or cage which is ventilated and safely secured to the motor vehicle or utility trailer.

Proposed law provides that the penalty for the violation of transporting one dog in violation of proposed law is a fine of not more than \$150.

Proposed law provides that an additional fine of \$50 per dog shall be imposed for each additional dog transported at the same time in violation of proposed law. Proposed law applies only to dogs of all breeds and not to any other animal.
