17 education, training, or examinations approved or administered by the exchange or
18 the United States Department of Health and Human Services.

19 D.(1) In order to make a determination of license eligibility, the
20 commissioner shall require fingerprints of applicants and submit the fingerprints and
21 the fees required to perform the criminal history record checks to the Louisiana
22 Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information for state and national criminal
23 history record checks. The commissioner shall require a criminal history record
24 check on each applicant in accordance with this Subsection. The commissioner shall
25 require each applicant to submit a full set of fingerprints in order for the
26 commissioner to obtain and receive National Criminal History Records from the
27 Criminal Justice Information Services Division of the Federal Bureau of
28 Investigation.

29 (2) The commissioner may contract for the collection, transmission, and
30 resubmission of fingerprints required under this Subsection. If the commissioner
31 does so, the fee for collecting and transmitting fingerprints and the fee for the
32 criminal history record check shall be payable directly to the contractor by the
33 applicant. The commissioner may agree to a reasonable fingerprinting fee to be
34 charged by the contractor.

35 (3) The commissioner shall treat and maintain an applicant's fingerprints and
36 any criminal history record information obtained under this Section as confidential
37 and shall apply security measures consistent with the Criminal Justice Information
38 Services Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation standards for the electronic
39 storage of fingerprints and necessary identifying information and limit the use of
40 records solely to the purposes authorized in this Section. The fingerprints and any
41 criminal history record information shall be exempt from the Public Records Law,
42 R.S. 44:1 et seq., shall not be subject to subpoena, other than a subpoena issued in
43 a criminal proceeding or investigation, shall be confidential by law and privileged,
44 and shall not be subject to discovery or admissible in evidence in any private civil
45 action."
