Fannin HB No. 677

Appropriates supplemental funding and provides for other budgetary adjustments for the 2012-2013 Fiscal Year.

Provides for a (\$37,629,609) reduction in State General Fund (Direct) in accordance with the governor's expenditure freeze, Executive Order BJ 2012-15.

Provides for other net increases (decreases) as follows: Interagency Transfers by \$21,909,389; Self-Generated Revenues by \$18,863,056; and Federal Funds by (\$5,928,372).

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Appropriations</u> to the <u>original</u> bill.

- 1. Deleted State General Fund (Direct) appropriations of \$120,025,511 (including \$25,900,000 of nonrecurring revenue). Provided for other net increases (decreases) as follows: Interagency Transfers by \$10,217,114; Self-Generated Revenues by \$1,031,958; and Federal Funds by (\$1,923,991).
- 2. Added a provision amending language in Act No. 23 of the 2012 R.S. (the Capital Outlay Act).
