

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Education to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 202 by Senator Nevers

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 14 and 15 and insert the following:

3 "A.(1) As part of the Louisiana Taylor Opportunity Program for
 4 Students, the state shall financially assist any student who enrolls on a full-
 5 time basis in a public college or university in this state or a regionally
 6 accredited independent college or university in the state that is a member of
 7 the Louisiana Association of Independent Colleges or Universities, hereafter
 8 in this Chapter referred to collectively as "eligible colleges or universities",
 9 to pursue an academic undergraduate degree or, as provided by this
 10 Subsection, skill or occupational training as defined by the Board of Regents,
 11 including a vocational or technical education certificate or diploma program
 12 or a nonacademic undergraduate degree, and who meets the qualifications of
 13 Subparagraph (b), (c), or (d) of this Paragraph and all of the applicable
 14 following qualifications:

 26 "Agriscience I; Agriscience II;" to "Agriscience I and Agriscience II (one unit
 27 combined);"

28 AMENDMENT NO. 7

29 On page 6, at the end of line 12, delete "Speech;" and at the beginning of line 13, delete
 30 "Debate;" and insert "Speech III and Speech IV (one unit combined);"
