SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 95

BY SENATOR WALSWORTH

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. Requests the Department of Children and Family Services in collaboration with stakeholders to study and make recommendations for a comprehensive statewide plan for the delivery of domestic violence services.

A RESOLUTION

2	To urge and request the Department of Children and Family Services to collaborate with
3	stakeholders to study and develop a comprehensive statewide plan for the delivery
4	of domestic violence services and to report its recommendations to the Senate
5	Committee on Health and Welfare on or before January 15, 2014.
6	WHEREAS, domestic violence is detrimental to the safety and psychological well-
7	being of Louisiana's citizens; and
8	WHEREAS, the state of Louisiana must maximize its resources to provide services
9	to the victims of domestic violence in a manner that prioritizes safety and results in long-
10	term, sustainable outcomes; and
11	WHEREAS, domestic violence funding in Louisiana is currently based on a model
12	which is mainly focused on shelters as opposed to models directed at primary and secondary
13	prevention programs with documented successful outcome measures; and
14	WHEREAS, research is warranted to determine whether Louisiana families would
15	receive a greater benefit from programs that focus on the root causes of domestic violence,
16	before victims are forced to utilize a shelter; and
17	WHEREAS, the Family Violence Prevention and Services Act encourages states to
18	implement comprehensive plans for domestic violence response.

1	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby			
2	urge and request the Department of Children and Family Services to collaborate with the			
3	following stakeholders to study and develop a comprehensive statewide plan for domestic			
4	violence services:			
5	(1)	A representative of the Louisiana Coalition Against Domestic Violence.		
6	(2)	A representative of the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement.		
7	(3)	A representative of the Louisiana Foundation Against Sexual Assault.		
8	(4)	A representative of the Louisiana Women's Policy and Research Commission.		
9	(5)	A representative of the Louisiana Association of Chiefs of Police.		
10	(6)	A representative of the Louisiana District Attorneys Association.		
11	(7)	A representative of the Louisiana Sheriffs' Association.		
12	(8)	A representative of the Louisiana Supreme Court Judicial Administrator's		
13		Office, with expertise in the administration of the Louisiana Protective Order		
14		Registry.		
15	(9)	A representative of the Louisiana Department of Justice, office of the		
16		attorney general.		
17	(10)	A representative of the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals, office		
18		of public health.		
19	(11)	A representative of the Louisiana Public Defender Board.		
20	(12)	A representative of the District Judges Association.		
21	(13)	A representative of the Louisiana Council of Juvenile and Family Court
