# DIGEST

## Morrell (SB 207)

<u>Present constitution</u> (Art X, Sec. 1(B)) establishes a city civil service system for a city having a population of over 400,000.

Present law provides relative to civil service for cities having a population exceeding 100,000.

<u>Present law</u> provides relative to fire and police civil service law for municipalities with a population between 250,000 and 500,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides that in the event that the civil service system of any city pursuant to <u>present constitution or law</u> is determined by final judgment of a court of competition jurisdiction to not be subject <u>present constitution or law</u>, the civil service of the city shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the state service system.

Effective August 1, 2013.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

## <u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Local and Municipal Affairs</u> to the original bill

1. Adds provisions regarding a court determination of inapplicability of <u>present</u> <u>constitution and law</u>.

- 1. Clarifies that the population size of a municipality shall be based upon the latest regular federal decennial census.
