# I. SUMMARY OF JOINT RESOLUTION

This report is for House Bill No. <u>206</u> of the 2013 Regular Session by Representative <u>Reynolds</u>, proposing to <u>amend Art. VIII, Sections 9 and 13(B) through (D)</u> of the Constitution.

HB 206 removes geographic limitations on the legislature's authority to create new school boards and amends certain provisions relative to financing education.

# **II. CONCLUSION**

The proposed measure cannot be accomplished statutorily.

HB 206 proposes to amend existing constitutional provisions relative to the creation of school boards which can only be accomplished by a constitutional amendment.
