



1 terms and conditions for such service delivery to be set forth in cooperative endeavor  
2 agreements among the state, LSU, and private providers; and

3 WHEREAS, the state, LSU, and Lake Charles Memorial Hospital intend to enter into  
4 a cooperative endeavor agreement to formalize a collaboration to improve access to health  
5 care in the Lake Charles area; and

6 WHEREAS, the cooperative endeavor agreement includes a provision to cease  
7 inpatient care and emergency room services at the W.O. Moss Medical Center in Lake  
8 Charles, Louisiana, which is currently operated by LSU; and

9 WHEREAS, the W.O. Moss Medical Center currently maintains and operates ten  
10 hospital beds for inpatient care and an active emergency room; and

11 WHEREAS, the legislature recognizes the need to maintain and continue proper  
12 health care in the Lake Charles area, including inpatient and emergency care; and

13 WHEREAS, the legislature recognizes, and the cooperative endeavor agreement will  
14 provide, that the inpatient and emergent care currently provided at the W.O. Moss Medical  
15 Center will be provided by the Lake Charles Memorial Hospital; and

16 WHEREAS, the cooperative endeavor agreement will provide that Lake Charles  
17 Memorial Hospital build a new medical facility adjacent to the W.O. Moss Medical Center  
18 which, when completed, will house outpatient clinics; and

19 WHEREAS, the outpatient services currently provided at the W.O. Moss Medical  
20 Center will be transferred to the new outpatient clinic built adjacent to the W.O. Moss  
21 Medical Center; and

22 WHEREAS, the legislature recognizes that the closure of the inpatient beds and the  
23 emergency room at W.O. Moss Medical Center requires authorization by the legislature  
24 through a concurrent resolution pursuant to Louisiana Revised Statute 17:1519.3.

25 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
26 endorse and express support of the actions by the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State  
27 University and Agricultural and Mechanical College with regard to the delivery of health  
28 care services in the Lake Charles region.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
30 endorse and support the ongoing and strategic collaboration among the Board of Supervisors

1 of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, the state, and Lake  
2 Charles Memorial Hospital to close the inpatient beds and emergency room at W.O. Moss  
3 Medical Center.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution constitutes legislative approval,  
5 in accordance with the requirements of R.S. 17:1519.3, for the closure of the inpatient beds  
6 and emergency room at W.O. Moss Medical Center.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
8 office of the governor, the commissioner of administration, the secretary of the Department  
9 of Health and Hospitals, and the chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State  
10 University and Agricultural and Mechanical College.
