HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 111

COMMENDATIONS: Commends the LSU gymnastics team on an outstanding 2013 season

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend the members of the Louisiana State University gymnastics team and their  
3 coaches on their outstanding 2013 season.

4 WHEREAS, this year's LSU gymnastics team advanced to the National Collegiate  
5 Athletic Association (NCAA) Super Six competition, and it is appropriate to commend  
6 everyone involved with this superb program for another record-setting season; and

7 WHEREAS, LSU finished the season ranked fifth in the country, the second highest  
8 finish in school history, and the team racked up ten NCAA All-American honors, tying the  
9 school record set in 2006 and again in 2009; and

10 WHEREAS, LSU won the NCAA Regional Title in Columbus, Ohio, and finished  
11 the season with twenty-five wins, including ten postseason wins, the most since the 1990  
12 squad won eleven; and

13 WHEREAS, the team tied the school record for the most scores of 197 in a season,  
14 scored the third best score in school history, and earned the highest finish at the SEC  
15 competition since 2006; and

16 WHEREAS, Sarie Morrison, Llominicia Hall, and Rheagan Courville earned perfect  
17 10.0 scores this season, Head Coach D-D Breaux received the Coach of the Year award at  
18 the NCAA Regional Meet, and Associate Head Coach Jay Clark and Assistant Head Coach  
19 Bob Moore were named Staff of the Year; and

20 WHEREAS, Rheagan Courville also earned SEC Gymnast of the Year, Central  
21 Region Gymnast of the Year, and Honda Award Finalist honors, captured the SEC All-

1 Around title and the vault and beam titles, becoming the first LSU gymnast to win three SEC  
2 titles in one season, finished 2013 with six All-American honors, including two on vault and  
3 two in the all-around, and was the National Runner-Up for the NCAA All-Around title, the  
4 second-highest finish in school history in the All-Around; and

5 WHEREAS, Llomincia Hall was ranked number one in the nation for most of the  
6 season on the floor exercise, won the SEC floor title for the second year in a row, becoming  
7 the third LSU gymnast to win two conference floor titles in a career, and earned two All-  
8 American honors on floor this season, including first-team recognition for the regular season  
9 and all SEC honors for the second straight year; and

10 WHEREAS, Jessica Savona won the SEC floor title, sharing the title with teammate  
11 Llomincia Hall and earning her All-SEC recognition after scoring a career high of 9.95, and  
12 was only the fourth LSU gymnast in school history to win the SEC floor title, joining Sandra  
13 Smith, Ashleigh-Clare Kearney and Ms. Hall; when Ms. Savona scored a 9.925 on floor in  
14 the season opener, she achieved the highest event score in a freshman's first meet in LSU  
15 history; and

16 WHEREAS, the members of this remarkable team and their coaches merit the  
17 highest commendation for their hard work, dedication, and record-setting achievements.

18 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
19 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the gymnasts and coaches of the LSU  
20 gymnastics team upon an outstanding 2013 season, does hereby record for posterity the  
21 immense pride that the members and coaches of this extraordinary team bring to their family  
22 and friends, LSU, and the state of Louisiana, does hereby congratulate them for their historic  
23 and magnificent achievements and accomplishments, and does hereby extend best wishes  
24 to all of the people involved with this premier gymnastics program as they celebrate their  
25 spectacular season and prepare for continued success in the future.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted  
27 to Head Coach D-D Breaux, Rheagan Courville, Llomincia Hall, and Jessica Savona.
