1 A RESOLUTION

2 To recognize Wednesday May 22, 2013, as Miss Louisiana Scholarship Organization Day
3 at the state capitol and to commend the current Miss Louisiana, Lauren Vizza, on her
4 many accomplishments.

5 WHEREAS, the Miss Louisiana Scholarship Organization is a part of the Miss
6 America Organization, the largest competitive scholarship program in the world and one of
7 the leading achievement programs in the United States; and

8 WHEREAS, in 2013, the Miss Louisiana Scholarship Organization and local
9 pageants across the state made available over \$634,000 in cash and tuition scholarships; and

10 WHEREAS, through the Miss Louisiana Scholarship Organization, contestants
11 compete for thousands of dollars in scholarships and gain poise, confidence, character, and
12 life skills that will benefit them, their community, and the state of Louisiana for years to
13 come; and

14 WHEREAS, the current Miss Louisiana 2012, Lauren Vizza, is a native of
15 Shreveport and attended Caddo Parish Magnet High School; and

16 WHEREAS, Lauren is a senior political science major at Louisiana Tech University
17 in Ruston and won a \$10,000 scholarship along with her Miss Louisiana crown; and

1 WHEREAS, Lauren currently serves as president of the College Republicans at
2 Louisiana Tech University, second vice president of the Louisiana Federation of College
3 Republicans, vice president of philanthropic services for Sigma Kappa Sorority, and director
4 of community service for the Louisiana Tech University Student Government Association;

6 WHEREAS, Lauren additionally serves as spokesperson for: March of Dimes
7 Louisiana, Louisiana Cares for Children, and the Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and
8 Sports, and she is a member of 88 Magnolias and the Freshman Leadership Team at
9 Louisiana Tech; and

10 WHEREAS, Lauren is also a student recruiter for Louisiana Tech, serves as a
11 counselor at Rock Solid Sports Camp, and plans to obtain a law degree and pursue a career
12 in foreign diplomacy upon her graduation from Louisiana Tech; and

13 WHEREAS, at Caddo Magnet High School, Lauren was an all-city, all-state, and all-
14 star soccer player, was named all-district soccer most valuable player, was the only female
15 to receive the KLSA-TV player of the week award during the 2008-2009 soccer season, and
16 was the captain of the gymnastics team; and

17 WHEREAS, in Miss Louisiana pageants, Lauren was the preliminary swimsuit
18 winner at Miss Louisiana 2012, fourth runner-up to Miss Louisiana 2011, and third runner-
19 up to Miss Louisiana 2012; and

20 WHEREAS, Lauren merits the highest measure of commendation for the tremendous
21 pride and honor that she brings to her family and friends, Louisiana Tech University, the
22 cities of Shreveport and Ruston, and the state of Louisiana.
