1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:62.4(A), relative to the crime of unauthorized entry of a place
3	of business; to provide relative to the definition of the crime of unauthorized entry
4	of a place of business; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 14:62.4(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§62.4. Unauthorized entry of a place of business
8	A. Unauthorized entry of a place of business is the intentional entry by a
9	person without authority into any structure or onto any premises, belonging to
10	another, that is completely enclosed by any type of physical barrier that is at least six
11	feet in height <mark>, or by a combination of any type of physical barrier that is at least</mark>
12	six feet in height and a lake, river, bayou, or other body of water, and that is
13	used in whole or in part as a place of business. Nothing in this Section shall
14	prohibit the ability of a person to dock a boat, vessel, or other watercraft on the
15	bank of a navigable waterway for a reasonable period of time under any of the
16	following circumstances:
17	(1) The watercraft is experiencing a mechanical or operating problem.
18	(2) Any person aboard the watercraft is experiencing a medical
19	emergency.
20	(3) Any other condition exists that prevents the watercraft from
21	proceeding on the waterway.

1	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
2	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
3	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
4	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
5	effective on the day following such approval.
