- 8 On page 3, between lines 12 and 13 insert:
 - "Y.(1) Notwithstanding any provision of this Chapter to the contrary, beginning with the 2013-2014 award year and thereafter, the maximum award amount provided by the state to an otherwise qualified student who is the recipient of an award granted pursuant to this Chapter and who enrolls in any public college or university in the state shall not exceed the award amount determined by the administering agency to equal the award amount paid at that public college or university for the 2012-2013 award year, plus ten percent.
 - (2) For an otherwise qualified student who is the recipient of an award granted pursuant to this Chapter, and who has enrolled in a regionally accredited independent college or university in the state which is a member of the Louisiana Association of Independent Colleges and Universities, the maximum award amount shall not exceed the award amount determined by the administering agency to equal the weighted average amounts awarded for students attending public colleges and universities in the state for the 2012-2013 award year, plus ten percent.
 - (3) The maximum award amounts specified in this Subsection shall be exclusive of any additional amounts awarded to students who qualify to receive a Performance Award or Honors Award.
 - (4) Beginning with the 2014-2015 fiscal year, and every other year thereafter, the administering agency shall consider any adjustments necessary to align the award amounts granted pursuant to this Chapter with the Higher Education Price Index and recommend any such adjustment to the legislature for approval during legislative sessions held in odd-numbered years."
