# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 148

### PUBLIC CONTRACTS: To create and form an Overhead Power Line Identification Work Group to study the issues surrounding overhead power lines and construction projects

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To create and form an Overhead Power Line Identification Work Group, led by the
3	Department of Transportation and Development, to identify a solution to problems
4	surrounding the identification of power lines for contractors prior to commencing
5	work.
6	WHEREAS, R.S. 45:141 et seq., the Louisiana Overhead Power Line Safety Act,
7	prohibits any work whatsoever within ten feet of a power line carrying in excess of six
8	hundred volts and requires a contractor to notify the owner of overhead lines at least forty-
9	eight hours prior to commencement of work; and
10	WHEREAS, there is a lack of information available for a contractor to readily
11	identify a utility company or companies that must be notified of the risk of construction
12	equipment coming into contact with, or in close enough proximity to cause arcing of
13	electricity with accompanying injury to construction workers or bystanders; and
14	WHEREAS, power lines are often in close proximity to construction projects, and
15	there is no process in place for identification of the operators of such lines nor are there any
16	laws in place to require overhead power line operators to locate and provide height and
17	voltage information about power lines; and
18	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Overhead Power Line Safety Act further requires that the
19	parties come to a satisfactory and mutual agreement for safety procedures within a certain
20	time frame; and

1	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Overhead Power Line Act also prohibits work from being
2	commenced by contractors until a "satisfactory mutual agreement" is reached; and
3	WHEREAS, there is no procedure to address circumstances where a "satisfactory
4	mutual agreement" is not reached and which party is then tasked with producing safety
5	procedures or paying for the costs of those procedures; and
6	WHEREAS, there are often costly delays to the completion of construction projects
7	due to the lack of the identification of overhead power lines; and
8	WHEREAS, contractors bear the responsibility and risk for working and operating
9	cranes and other equipment in the vicinity of overhead power lines; and
10	WHEREAS, House Bill No. 487 of the 2013 Regular Session of the Legislature by
11	Representative Stuart Bishop sought to require designers of projects to identify the location,
12	wattage, and height of power lines; and
13	WHEREAS, House Bill No. 487 of the 2013 Regular Session of the Legislature
14	sparked much discussion by contractors, utility companies, and design professionals; and
15	WHEREAS, all parties decided that the matter of identification of location, wattage,
16	and height of power lines is a complex issue that will require further formal study and
17	discussion to formulate an equitable and reasonable solution to a problem that currently has
18	none.
19	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
20	authorize and establish the Overhead Power Line Identification Work Group which shall
21	report its recommendations regarding the identification of ownership, location, wattage, and
22	height of power lines for contractors and related issues to the House and Senate committees
23	on transportation, highways, and public works.
24	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the work group created herein shall consist of
25	the following members:
26	(1) The secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development or his
27	designee.
28	(2) The director of the office of facility planning and control or his designee.
29	(3) The president of the Louisiana Associated General Contractors or his designee.

1	(4) The vice president of regulatory and governmental affairs of Entergy Louisiana
2	or his designee.
3	(5) The senior vice president of commercial operations of Cleco Power, LLC,
4	(CLECO) or his designee.
5	(6) The vice president of external affairs for Southwestern Electric Power Company
6	(SWEPCO) or his designee.
7	(7) One member appointed by the Association of Louisiana Electric Cooperatives.
8	(8) The president of the Police Jury Association of Louisiana or his designee.
9	(9) The president of the Louisiana Municipal Association or his designee.
10	(10) The president of the American Council of Engineering Companies of Louisiana
11	or his designee.
12	(11) The president of the Louisiana Society of Professional Surveyors or his
13	designee.
14	(12) The president of the Louisiana Architects Association or his designee.
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the work group shall identify the issues
16	surrounding the identification of location, wattage, and height of power lines by design
17	professionals for contractors, as well as related issues, and make specific recommendations
18	regarding legislation to be introduced to address the issues identified.
19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the work group shall convene its first meeting
20	no later than August 1, 2013.
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the work group shall notify the following
22	persons of the time, date, and location of each work group meeting: the chairwoman of the
23	House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works, the chairman of the
24	Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works, the chairman of the
25	House Committee on Commerce, the chairman of the Senate Committee on Commerce,
26	Consumer Protection, and International Affairs, the senator representing Senate District
27	Number 27, and the member of the House of Representatives representing House District
28	Number 43.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the work group shall submit a written report of 2 its findings and recommendations to the House and Senate committees on transportation, 3 highways, and public works no later than January 1, 2014. 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be transmitted 5 to the secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development, the office of facility 6 planning, Louisiana Associated General Contractors, Entergy Louisiana, LLC, Cleco Power, 7 LLC, Southwestern Electric Power Company, the Association of Louisiana Electrical 8 Cooperatives, the Police Jury Association of Louisiana, the Louisiana Municipal 9 Association, the American Council of Engineering Companies of Louisiana, the Louisiana

10 Society of Professional Surveyors, and the Louisiana Architects Association.
