8	approved payments through credit and debit cards; and
9	WHEREAS, there are multiple providers and policies relative to the use of approved
0	credit and debit cards for the payment of state charges; and
1	WHEREAS, the opportunity may exist for Louisiana entities to provide credit and
12	debit card services.
13	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
14	urge and request the state treasurer to submit a report to the Louisiana Legislature by January
15	15, 2014, on credit and debit card transactions used for payment of obligations to state
16	agencies.
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the state treasurer shall include the following in the
18	report:
19	(1) The amount of fee charged per credit or debit card use.
20	(2) Any other costs associated with credit or debit card use.
