AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 47:1992(B), (F), and (G)(1) and (2)(b), relative to tax 3 assessments in Orleans Parish; to extend the period of time for the assessor of Orleans Parish to submit certain lists to the board of review; to extend the period of 4 5 time for inspection of assessment lists in Orleans Parish; to provide relative to complaints received by the Orleans Parish assessor's office; to extend the period of 6 7 time for the Orleans Parish assessor to forward certain complaints to the board of 8 review; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters. 9 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published 10 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of 11 Louisiana. 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 13 Section 1. R.S. 47:1992(B), (F), and (G)(1) and (2)(b) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 14 15 §1992. Inspection of assessment lists; notification and review of assessments by 16 board of review; hearing officers 17 18 B.(1) Except as provided for in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection, after After 19 the lists of each assessor have been exposed for inspection for the period provided 20 for in Subsection F of this Section, the lists as changed by each assessor shall be 21 certified to the board of review within three days, which board shall conduct public 22 hearings for all persons or their representatives desiring to be heard on the

assessments of immovable and movable property. Notice of such public hearings shall be given by each assessor in accordance with rules and regulations established by the tax commission Louisiana Tax Commission.

(2) In Orleans Parish, after the list of the assessor has been exposed for inspection for the period provided for in Subsection G of this Section, the assessor shall certify the list as changed by the assessor and shall submit such list to the board of review by October first of each year. The board of review shall conduct public hearings for all persons or their representatives desiring to be heard on the assessments of immovable and movable property. Notice of public hearings shall be given by the Orleans Parish assessor in accordance with rules and regulations established by the Louisiana Tax Commission.

- F. Except in the parish of Orleans, the The period for inspection of the assessment lists as provided for in this Section in each parish shall, for the tax year beginning 1990 and in every tax year thereafter, be a period of fifteen days, beginning no earlier than August fifteenth and ending no later than September fifteenth. Beginning in tax year 2013 and in every tax year thereafter, the period for inspection of the assessment lists in Orleans Parish shall be for a period of thirty-two calendar days, beginning no earlier than July fifteenth and ending no later than August fifteenth of each year. However, for the year 2005 only, the September fifteenth deadline for completion of the period for inspection shall be suspended and waived.
- G. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the procedure for inspection of assessment lists in Orleans Parish shall be as follows:
- (1) The assessor shall prepare and make up the lists showing the assessment of immovable and movable property in Orleans Parish. <u>Beginning in tax year 2013</u> and in every tax year thereafter, the The lists shall be exposed daily, except Saturday, Sunday, and legal holidays, for inspection by the taxpayers and other interested persons during the period of August first <u>July fifteenth</u> through August fifteenth of each year unless August fifteenth falls on a weekend or a legal holiday, when the
