2	To commend the Louisiana Alliance of the Boys & Girls Clubs and the 2013 Boys & Girls
3	Club Youth of the Year, Andrew Vessell.
4	WHEREAS, in both rural and urban areas, youth of this nation are struggling to
5	create a bright future in the face of crime, substance abuse, low fitness levels, and high
6	dropout rates; and
7	WHEREAS, often young people need professional youth services to realize their full
8	potential as productive, caring responsible citizens; and
9	WHEREAS, the Boys & Girls Clubs provide programming for youth designed to
10	develop character and leadership skills, health and life skills, education and career
11	development, as well as exposure to the arts and sports and recreation; and
12	WHEREAS, to fulfill its mission, the Boys & Girls Clubs in Louisiana employ over
13	420 people and maintain an additional 1,600 volunteers who work to provide a supportive
14	relationship and help mentoring the youth at the thirty-two different Boys & Girls Clubs
15	sites; and
16	WHEREAS, the Boys & Girls Clubs encourage young people by providing a positive
17	and safe environment and promoting and recognizing teens that have developed sound
18	character, leadership abilities, and a willingness to give back to their communities; and

1	WHEREAS, the highest honor for a Boys & Girls Club member is the Boys and Girls
2	Clubs' Youth of the Year award that recognizes teens for outstanding contributions to a
3	member's family, school, community, and Boys & Girls Clubs; and
4	WHEREAS, the program also acknowledges the personal challenges faced by a
5	candidate and the obstacles an individual has overcome in his life; and
6	WHEREAS, winners of the Youth of the Year award are selected on the basis of
7	scholastic achievement, community service, leadership ability, and the consideration of any
8	physical, social, or emotional obstacles that have been overcome; and
9	WHEREAS, the 2013 Louisiana Boys and Girls Club Youth of the Year has been
10	awarded to Andrew Vessell, selected from the over 27,000 young people being served in the
11	Boys & Girls Clubs sites across the state; and
12	WHEREAS, the winner of this prestigious contest is also awarded a \$1,000 college
13	scholarship, with state winners having the opportunity to be selected as a Regional Youth
14	of the Year and a National Youth of the Year, each award providing additional scholarships;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, Andrew Vessell is a senior at Belaire High School and a six-year
17	member of the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Baton Rouge; and
18	WHEREAS, Andrew intends to begin college in the fall at Northwestern State
19	University, majoring in theater; and
20	WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary
21	accomplishments of Andrew as well as the staff and volunteers of the Louisiana Alliance of
22	the Boys & Girls Clubs be appropriately recognized.
23	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
24	does hereby recognize the Boys & Girls Clubs of Louisiana for a demonstrated commitment
25	to improving the lives of others in this state and the Louisiana Boys & Girls Club 2013
26	Youth of the Year, Andrew Vessell.
