Provides relative to registration of certain home improvement contractors. (8/1/13)

<u>Present law</u> provides no person shall undertake, offer to undertake, or agree to perform home improvement contracting services unless registered with and approved by the Residential Building Contractors Subcommittee of the State Licensing Board for Contractors as a home improvement contractor. Provides for a list of exceptions to the registration requirement, one of which is an exception for a homeowner who physically performs home improvement work on his personal residence. <u>Proposed law</u> expands the exception to a person who physically performs home improvement work on other property owned by him when the work has a value of less than \$7,500.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation will have a minimal decrease in self-generated revenues of the Louisiana State Licensing Board of Contractors (LSLBC) as a result of the new exception to the registration requirement. Registration fees are \$75 annually. The LSLBC has no way of determining how many individuals would fall into this new category; therefore the impact on revenues, if any is indeterminable.
