2	To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1601(A) and to repeal R.S. 40:1601(C)(3), relative to novelty
3	lighters; to provide for definitions and application; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 40:1601(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
6	\$1601. Novelty lighters
7	A. For the purposes of this Section, the following definitions shall apply
8	unless otherwise indicated:
9	(1) "Lighter" or "cigarette lighter" means a flame-producing product
10	commonly used by consumers to ignite cigarettes, cigars, and pipes, although the
11	lighter may be used to ignite other materials. The term does not include matches or
12	any other lighting device intended primarily for igniting materials other than
13	smoking materials, such as fuel for fireplaces or for charcoal or gas-fired grills.
14	means a flame-producing device commonly used by consumers to ignite tobacco
15	products and mechanical devices primarily used to ignite fuel for fireplaces or for
16	charcoal or gas grills. The term does not include matches. This term includes
17	novelty lighters.
18	(2) "Novelty lighter" means a mechanical or electrical device typically used
19	for the igniting or lighting of cigarettes, cigars, or pipes lighter that has a toylike
20	appearance, has entertaining audio or visual effects, or resembles in any way in form
21	or function an item that is commonly recognized as appealing, attractive, or intended
22	for use by young children, particularly those ten years of age or younger, including
23	such a device that takes toylike physical forms, including but not limited to toy
