

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 90 by Representative Mack

LAW ENFORCEMENT: Authorizes DPS&C to provide bulletproof vests to other law enforcement agencies

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Deleted the provision authorizing the La. Property Assistance Agency to charge a fee not in excess of \$5 per request.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law requires DPS&C to provide bulletproof vests to every peace officer in the state of La. provided that funds are appropriated for this purpose.

Proposed law further provides that to the extent that funds are not appropriated for this purpose, DPS&C may make available for purchase to law enforcement agencies bulletproof vests no longer utilized by the department for which the manufacturer warranty has expired.

Proposed law further provides that any purchase shall be conducted pursuant to rules or regulations adopted by the La. Property Assistance Agency.

Proposed law provides that the state of La., its agencies and assigns, including but not limited to DPS&C shall be immune from any liability relating to or resulting from the purchase, issuance, or failure of bulletproof vests transferred pursuant to proposed law.
