
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs to Reengrossed House Bill No. 636 by Representative Danahay

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 4, line 24, after "finding" delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 25 through
3 27, and on page 5, delete lines 1 through 5, and insert:

4 "that the balance in the fund is less than five million dollars and that an
5 unauthorized discharge of oil in excess of one hundred thousand gallons has
6 occurred as certified by the coordinator. In addition, the fee shall be levied
7 at the rate of one-half cent per barrel if the state treasurer certifies in writing
8 to the secretary of the Department of Revenue that the balance in the fund is
9 less than five million dollars due to expenditures from the fund under the
10 authority of R.S. 30:2484(A)(2) or (3) or (4) or (7) so long as the
11 expenditures under the authority of R.S. 30:2484(A)(7) is for costs and
12 contracts exclusive of administrative and personnel costs of the office of the
13 coordinator."

14 AMENDMENT NO. 2

15 On page 5, line 17, after "upon" insert "the first day of the second calendar quarter following
16 a"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 3

18 On page 5, line 19, after "into the" delete the remainder of the line, delete line 20, on line 21,
19 delete "Trust Fund" and insert the following:

20 "Gulf Coast Restoration Trust Fund established pursuant to Section 1602 of
21 the Resources and Ecosystems Sustainability, Tourist Opportunities, and
22 Revived Economies of the Gulf Coast States (RESTORE) Act ,"
