In addition, the fee shall be levied at the rate of one-half cent per barrel if the state treasurer certifies in writing 7 to the secretary of the Department of Revenue that the balance in the fund is 8 9 less than five million dollars due to expenditures from the fund under the authority of R.S. 30:2484(A)(2) or (3) or (4) or (7) so long as the 10 expenditures under the authority of R.S. 30:2484(A)(7) is for costs and 11 contracts exclusive of administrative and personnel costs of the office of the 12 13 coordinator."
