2	To enact R.S. 14:67.29, relative to misappropriation without violence; to create the crime
3	of false personation of a veteran or fraudulent representation of a veteran-owned
4	business; to provide for definitions; to provide penalties; and to provide for related
5	matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 14:67.29 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§67.29. False personation of a veteran or fraudulent representation of a
9	veteran-owned business
10	A. False personation of a veteran is the false representation by a person
11	of being a veteran, with the intent to injure, defraud, obtain economic gain, or
12	obtain or secure any special privilege or advantage.
13	B. Fraudulent representation of a veteran-owned business is the false
14	representation by an owner, operator, principal, or employee of a business that
15	the business is owned by a veteran or is a service-connected disabled veteran-
16	owned business, with the intent to injure, defraud, obtain economic gain, or
17	obtain or secure any special privilege or advantage.
18	C. For the purposes of this Section, "veteran" means a person who has
19	served in the armed services or reserve forces of the United States or Louisiana
20	National Guard.
21	D. Whoever commits the crime of false personation of a veteran or
22	fraudulent representation of a veteran-owned business shall be fined not more
23	than one thousand dollars, or imprisoned for not more than six months, or both.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 3 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana.
