**Protection District** 

Purpose of Bill: This measure allows for an increase in per diem rates paid to the governing board members of the Bienville Parish Ward 4 and 5 Fire Protection District. It increases per diem from \$30 to \$250 for the board chairman and from \$30 to \$50 for the other board members. In addition, this measure reduces the maximum number of meetings in which a board member can be paid a per diem from 24 to 14 times per year.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

This bill may increase local fund expenditures \$2,700 annually for the Bienville Parish Ward 4 and 5 Fire **Protection District.** 

The board consists of four board members and one chairman. Currently, if the board meets for the maximum times allowable (24 meetings), annual expenditures under present law could be up to \$3,600. Under this measure, if the board meets the maximum number of times allowed to earn per diem (14 meetings), annual expenditures could be up to \$6,300. Therefore the proposed legislation may increase per diem expenditures by \$2,700 annually (\$6,300 - \$3,600 = \$2,700).

<u>Maximum Per Diem under current law</u> = 24 meetings x 4 board members and chairman x \$30 = \$3,600<u>Maximum Per Diem under proposed law</u> =  $(14 \text{ meetings } \times 1 \text{ chairman } \times \$250) + (14 \text{ meetings } \times 4 \text{ board members } \times \$50) =$ \$6,300

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
