- necessary to fully protect the shrimp industry in Louisiana and other states from this
- disease; and"

- 15 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 10 and insert the following:

- well-being of the region, and is still threatened by and suffering from the enormous
- impacts of recent natural and manmade disasters.
