SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY

EN NO IMPACT See Note

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Provides relative to sex offender registration and notification requirements for offenders convicted pursuant to the laws of another state who establish a residence in La.

Present law provides that any person convicted of an offense under the laws of another state who establishes residency in Louisiana shall be required to register as a sex offender and provide notification pursuant to Louisiana law; provides that a person so registered shall do so for the period of time required by his state of conviction or by Louisiana criminal provisions, whichever is longer; requires the bureau to determine the period of registration and frequency of in-person renewals applicable to such offenders; and provides that until such determinations are made the offender shall apear for in-person renewals every three months. Proposed law retains present law but provides that if the period of registration required by the offender's jurisdiction of conviction is for the duration of the offender's lifetime, the bureau shall not be required to determine which time period of registration and frequency of in-person renewals would be applicable to the offender while living in Louisiana. Proposed law establishes that the duration of registration for any such offender shall be the duration of his or her lifetime and that the frequency of in-person renewals shall be every three months from the date of initial registration.
